WONDER and COURAGE Programs:

Monday to Thursday - between 9:00am - 11.30am and early afternoon

ACTIVE Program:

Monday to Friday - between 3:45pm - 5:45pm

Saturday - between 9:00am - 11.30am

The duration of each class is 30 minutes

NB: Days and times on offer may change each term according to instructor availability.

PAYMENT:

- Swim & Survive term and Holiday programs must be paid in full payment at the time of enrolment.
- Private program must be paid for by Week 5, during the Swim and Survive term .

CANCELLATIONS

Swim and Survive:

The Hamilton Indoor Leisure and Aquatic Centre must be notified of program cancellations prior to the program commencement. The value of the cancelled program, less an administration fee (equivalent to one lesson) will be credited to your HILAC family account to be used towards a next set of lessons.

Any unattended lessons will be forfeited and no refunds or credits apply unless a medical certificate is provided or extenuating circumstances can be proven.

Private Swim Tuition Cancellations

If unable to attend a class please let us know at least 4 hours in advance. If the class is already paid for, your HILAC account will be credited with the correct amount and this can be used towards any future classes or to pay for some other activities at HILAC. If you do not attend a class without notification and the instructor is present you will be charged for that class.

AQUATIC EDUCATION 2012



PROGRAMS

- ♦ **Wonder** = 6 mths – 3 years
- ♦ **Courage** = 3 - 5 years
- ♦ **Active** = 5 - 15 years
- ♦ **Private** = term & holiday
- ♦ **Adults**

All instructors are AUSTSWIM-Teachers of Swimming and Water Safety qualified.



Swim Program Levels

WONDER 6mths – 3 years

Wonder represents the first stage in a lifetime of fun and safety in the water, so it is only natural that it is approached in a way that builds on a child's natural curiosity and fascination with water.

- ◆ **Wonder 1 (6-12months)**
- ◆ **Wonder 2 (12 -24 months)**
 - **Stage 3 (12-18 months)**
 - **Stage 4 (18-24 months)**
- ◆ **Wonder 3 (24 – 36 months)**
 - **Stage 5 (24– 30 months)**
 - **Stage 6 (30—36 months)**

A responsible adult is required to join the child in the pool in the above classes at all times.

COURAGE 3 - 5 years

Courage is fundamental to the development of basic foundation skills in swimming, survival and water safety, as is a positive attitude towards learning these essential skills. It is all about having LOTS of FUN whilst learning.

- ◆ **Courage 1** - absolute beginner
- ◆ **Courage 2**- little aquatic experience
- ◆ **Courage 3** - front/ back floating assisted
- ◆ **Courage 4** -float unassisted/ face submerged
- ◆ **Courage 5** - move through water 3m

A responsible adult MAY be required to join the child in the group until the child feels safe

ACTIVE 5 - 15 years

Active is used to emphasise that the skills learnt in the program not only save lives, but provide a foundation for participation in a range of aquatic recreation, fitness and sporting activities. The progression is skill based and participants advance at their own pace, from beginners to confident, ready for squad swimmers.

BRONZE

Aims to develop safe water knowledge; rescue and survival skills; basic resuscitation skills for secondary school aged children. Usually timetabled Term 2 and 4, subject to enrolment numbers.

PRIVATE SWIM TUITION &

HOLIDAY INTENSIVE PROGRAMS

4 YEARS—ADULTS

During the Swim and Survive term, private swim tuition will be offered to coincide with the timetabled program. Instructor availability will determine places offered. Holiday Programs can be arranged at a time that mutually suits you and our instructor.

Private lessons are offered for the Swim and Survive Active program (Ages 4-15years) and Adults. These will be conducted by an AUSTSWIM qualified instructor.

THE DURATION OF EACH CLASS IS 30 MINUTES,
Private lessons may only have 1 participant per program.

ADULTS

Adult group lessons available Tuesday nights, subject to minimum enrolment requirements and instructor availability

WONDER and COURAGE:

Wonder and Courage program will run on an 8 week schedule.

Term 1: Wednesday 1st February to 24th March

(No lessons on Saturday 10th March & Public Holiday Monday 12th March)

(Term 2: Week beginning April 16th to June 7th

(No lessons Public Holiday 25th April—ANZAC day, Saturday 9th June and Public Holiday Monday 11th June)

Term 3: Week beginning July 16th to Sept 8th

Term 4: Week beginning Oct 8th to Dec 1st

(No lessons on Melbourne Cup Day, Tuesday 6th November)

ACTIVE:

Active program will run on a 10 week schedule.

Term 1: Wednesday 1st February to 30th March (9 weeks)

(No lessons on Saturday 10th March & Public Holiday Monday 12th March)

Term 2: Week Beginning April 16th to June 23rd

(No lessons Public Holiday 25th April—ANZAC day, Saturday 9th June and Public Holiday Monday 11th June)

Term 3: Week Beginning July 16th to Sept 22nd

Term 4: Week Beginning Oct 8th to Dec 15th

(No lessons on Melbourne Cup Day, Tuesday 6th November)

BRONZE: Timetabled for Term 2 & 4

Program Fees

NOTE: Allow for pricing adjustment if a term is for less than 10 weeks (8 for Infant Aquatics) or if there is a public holiday. Aquatic Education will run for a maximum of 10 weeks even if the school term is longer.
