HILAC Occasional Care provides quality care for Children between the ages of 7 weeks 7 years old: operating between the hours of 9am to 12noon Monday to Fridays, including school holidays.

Can I use the Child Care Centre if I'm not using the Leisure facilities?

Yes, our service is available to families with appointments, work or study outside HILAC as well as families using the sporting facilities

How much does it cost? \$9.50 per hour part of

Child Care Benefit & Rebate can be claimed by families eligible to receive these payments

What does my child need to bring?

A Clearly Named Bag Containing-

- ❖ A change of clothing
- ❖ Nappies or a change or underwear
- Comforter e.g. toy, blanket, dummy
- ❖ Warm coat and beanie for winter outside play
- ❖ Wide brim hat for summer outside play
- ❖ A pram or pusher if child is likely to nap

Does my child need to bring food?

Yes, the children sit down together for morning tea around 10.15 am and again at 11.30am: it's important for a child/toddler to join in this social routine it helps them feel part of the group.

Parents Need to Provide-

- ❖ A healthy snack e.g. fruit, yoghurt, cheese and crackers in a clearly named container
- ❖ Water bottle clearly named
- ❖ Baby bottle; made up and named
- Lunch if required e.g. sandwich, baby food

Please note we discourage NUTS being brought into the centre due to allergies.

How do I book a place for My Child?

Bookings and payments are conducted at HILAC reception; bookings are advised to secure your child a place. Enrolment forms are available from reception & HILAC website and must be completed before your child can attend.
